We carry out the requirements for Title I schools in the following ways:



General Requirements

- → South Lake involves parents with determining how family involvement funds are spent by gathering feedback during monthly parent cafe meetings. Survey questions and after meeting evaluations to provide topics for future meetings
- → South Lake parents are involved in the development, review, and improvement of the school's school improvement plan, parent engagement plan and school-parent compact throughout the year.
 - Daily phone calls to parents(providing resources and supports)
 - ◆ Before and after school parent contact in person
- → South Lake will distribute the Parent Engagement plan electronically through the following social media platforms; class dojo, ConnectED, school website.
- → South Lake will hold an annual Title I meeting on **September 27, 2022 during the Parent Cafe** to provide information about the Title I program, parental rights, and the important role parents play in their children's education. Information will also be posted on the school website.
- → South Lake gathers parents' comments and feedback about the Schoolwide Plan (SIP) at the parent cafe. Meeting notes and evaluation are shared with MCPS Title I.
- → South Lake provides timely information about school programs on a daily basis via class dojo, ConnectEd and school website



Building Capacity

- → South Lake provides a presentation, one-on-one support and video explanations during parent cafes to help parents to understand the assessments used to measure academic progress, the challenging State academic standards, State and local academic assessments, how to monitor child's progress, and how to work with educators to improve achievement of their children.
- → South Lake teachers, reading specialists and staff development teachers work closely with parent community coordinators to support families and help parents improve their children's academic achievement during parent training in person/virtual and on new platforms and create "How to" videos to support technology needs.
