**Question**

During the *Review of High School Student Progress Data* discussion, Ms. Dixon requested that staff disaggregate the MAP data included in the presentation by school.

**Response**

The attached tables detail the number and percentage of students in Grades 3, 6, and 9 that scored at or above the 50th percentile in Measures of Academic Progress–Reading (MAP-R) or Measures of Academic Progress–Mathematics (MAP-M) in fall 2020. Data are disaggregated by service groups and are presented by school. With regard to the reporting, data suppression rules were applied according to federal guidelines.
