Linkages to Learning is a collaboration among Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services, Montgomery County Public Schools, and nonprofit community partners.

- Provide accessible prevention and early intervention services to at-risk children and their families in order to improve adjustment to and performance in school, home and community
- Integrated approach to health, social services, community development, and engagement to support student learning, strong families, and healthy communities to overcome obstacles to learning and growth

#### CASE MANAGEMENT

EveryMind's licensed clinicians and interns provide help for school-age youth (ages 9 and older) dealing with behavioral issues at school and home such as truancy, anger management, and bullying – to cultivate healthy behaviors and improve coping skills.

- Services for youth and their families includes promoting and integrating resources (employment, mental health, community service and recreational activities), psychoeducation – individually and in a group setting, and guidance and support for at-risk youth or those involved with Department of Juvenile Services

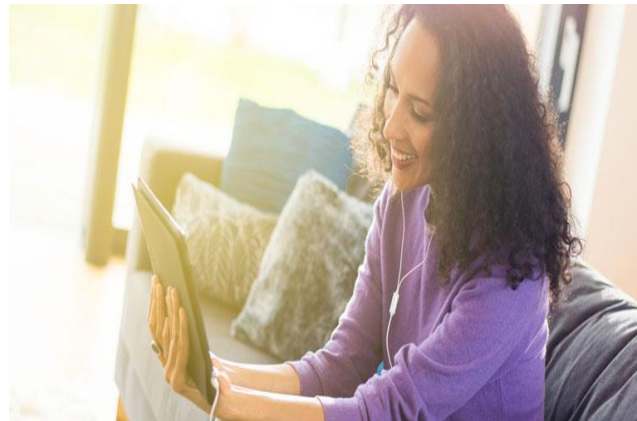
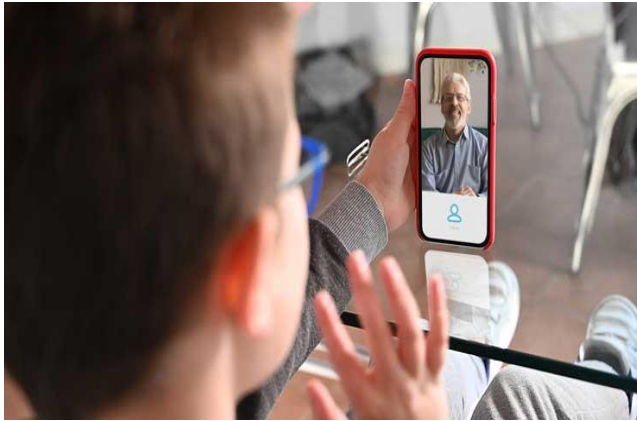
