I am pleased to report that Brooke Grove is slated to receive security cameras on both the interior and exterior of our school. Mr. Gulati and I completed a walk through with our MCPS Security staff and the contractor. The cameras are due to be installed this summer. I am also excited to report that we will receive a "playground refresh" this summer. This includes resetting the timbers, taking out some of the older equipment and replacing it with new play equipment, and the fence contractors will make some adjustments to the boundary fence. It will be a busy summer at The Grove!

Yesterday the Board of Education approved a plan for MCPS to hold virtual instruction on inclement weather days. The virtual instruction will not replace traditional snow days, but will be utilized if there are weather conditions that are extended.
