Arrival Procedures

- All Kindergarten students will wear a Kinder Card for the first week of school!
- Safety patrol and adult supervision begins at 8:40 a.m.
- Breakfast is served at 8:40 am.
- Kindergarten students line up in the cafeteria between 8:40 and 8:50. We walk to our classrooms at 8:50.
- Students arriving after 9:00 a.m. will be marked tardy. They should check into the office before coming to the classroom.

Dismissal Procedures

- Dismissal begins at 3:25 p.m.
- Bus Riders: Safety patrols pick up students from the classroom
- Walkers: Teachers will dismiss from the classroom door (#29)
- Kidsco: Students will be picked up from the classroom by a member of the Kidsco staff!

Leaving School



- If your child will be leaving school any other way than the usual departure method we must have a note from you.
- If your child is going home with another student in the class or school, both students must have a note.
- Please call the office in the event of an emergency, or if there is a last minute change.
- You must sign your child out in the office if he/she leaves school early.




