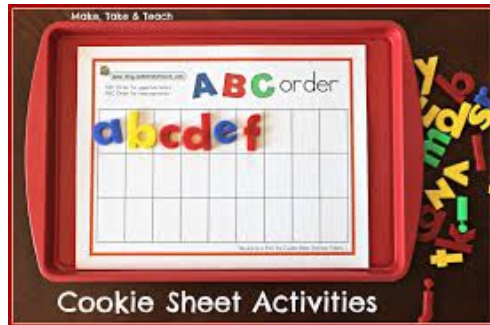

Literacy

This month, in literacy, we are focusing on the theme, My Family. The students will be learning to demonstrate an understanding of basic features of print. They will learn to recognize upper and lower case letters of the alphabet. They will also begin to identify words in a sentence by using snap cubes as each word is said in a sentence.

Math

This month, in math, the students will identify written numerals 0-10. They will verbally count to 10 by ones and then develop rote counting to 20 by ones. Students will be identifying simple shapes, sorting, measuring and comparing lengths.
