4 Pillars of Community Schools

- ✓ **Integrated Student Supports**

- ✓ **Expanded and Enriched Opportunities**
Essential to schools’ capacity to support students’ academic growth, as well as to help them develop socially, emotionally, and physically.
- ✓ **Family and Community Engagement**
Fostering relationships and building the capacity of stakeholders and the schools to leveraging local resources and ongoing engagement of families.
- ✓ **Collaborative Leadership Practices**
Developing a shared vision and goals and creating participatory practices for distributing responsibilities, a community school leverages the collective expertise of all of its stakeholders.
