MATH FOCUS

This month, we begin working within Module 3 of the Eureka curriculum. Students expand their skill with and understanding of units by bundling ones, tens, and hundreds up to a thousand with straws. Instruction includes a great deal of counting: by ones, tens, and hundreds. Along with changing 10 ones for 1 ten. Students now also change 10 tens for 1 hundred.

READING & WRITING

We have been reviewing skills learned in 1st grade as well as working on long vowel sounds, tricky words, fluent reading and punctuation. We will continue to work through our second skills unit which focuses on inflectional endings, the writing process and spelling. In our Knowledge unit, we will continue to learn about early asian civilizations, including learning about Diwali, Buddhism, and the important geography of ancient asia. As we wrap up early asian civilizations, we will start on ancient greek civilizations, where we will talk about Mt.Olympus, the Olympics, Alexander the Great and more. With the Knowledge unit, they hear read alouds, answer comprehension questions and complete writing activities.



SCIENCE

Students will investigate matter and properties of matter (color, size, texture), and determine how properties of matter help scientists determine which materials are best suited for a given purpose. Students will then engage in an engineering design challenge to construct a playground structure design that can withstand heavy use and heavy rain that causes the playground to flood.
