As a reminder, devices are in limited supply and are reserved for students who do not have access to a computer or laptop at home. Please read the following instructions before arriving at Rosemont tomorrow morning.

Please do the following BEFORE coming on Friday:

- Write your student's name, identification number, and school name in large writing on a piece of paper before arriving at Rosemont. This needs to be seen by the person greeting the cars and distributing the laptops.
- If you don't know your child's ID #, here are two ways to find it out before you come:
 - Ask your child what is the 6-digit number they use to log-into their Chromebooks when at school, or
 - It can be found on the top left of their report card (to the right of their name)

An adult must accompany any student who wishes to pick up a laptop. If you are unable to pick up a laptop during the distribution time, MCPS will provide information on additional opportunities for laptop pick up in the coming days.
