# Literacy, Language, and Vocabulary

• <u>Literary text</u>: Point of view, compare and contrast two versions of the same story by different authors/cultures, recount/describe key details from a text read aloud, use glossaries and beginning dictionaries, shades of meaning in words.

<u>Informational Text:</u> ask and answer questions, identifying the main topic, context clues-meaning of words/phrases, clarifying images in text, identify and use various text features, and naming the reasons that support an author's point of view.



## Writing

• <u>Informative</u>: ideas, topic, developing points, answer a question, using proper capitalization, incorporating spelling patterns, expanding and rearranging sentences.

**Opinion:** Organization, reasons to support an opinion, and conclusion.



## **Math**

- · Compare 3-digit numbers using >, <, and =.
- . Counting, addition, subtraction with 10's and 100's, 10 more/10 less, 100 more/100 less mentally.
- . Categorical data: plotting/interpreting data on bar and picture graphs.
- . Solving addition and subtraction situations with unknowns in all positions.
- . Adding to, taking from, putting together and taking apart.
- . Basic addition and subtraction fact progressions.



#### **Science**

- . Describing and comparing the properties of rocks and soil.
- Description of Earth's surface: Properties of water.
- . Using a scientific method for cleaning dirty water.
- . Natural features of continents
