Spelling	• Each week we practice specific spelling skills for 30 minutes every morning. These lessons teach students to use letter/sound knowledge to read and write. Spelling/reading quizzes are given at the end of each weekly unit. Points will only be taken off if a skill we have taught is not used correctly. If students are able to spell words which make sense phonetically, and we have not taught that skill specifically, then half points or no points will be taken off (depending on the skill level).

## Homework

- Please use the Eureka red SUCCEED book for optional math homework. Students should only spend 10 minutes a night on this. This book can also be helpful if you want to learn the strategies we are teaching the students in class.
