SUPPLEMENTAL EXAMINATIONS

Supplemental examinations are offered in any section of a Grade 10 and Teacher's ARCT practical examination for candidates who wish to improve their marks in a particular section of an examination, according to the following conditions:

- Supplemental examinations will be taken during regularly scheduled examination sessions.
- A supplemental examination comprises only one section of an examination.
- Candidates may take a maximum of *two* supplemental examinations *per grade*.
- Any supplemental examinations must be completed within *two years* of the original examination.

Please note: supplemental examinations are not offered for Performer's ARCT in Violin.

Grade 10

In order to be eligible to take a supplemental examination in Grade 10, candidates must have attempted the complete examination within the last two years, achieved a *minimum total mark of 65*, and obtained *at least 70 percent* in the Repertoire section of the examination.

Teacher's ARCT

In order to be eligible to take a supplemental examination at the ARCT level, candidates must have attempted the complete examination within the last two years, achieved a *minimum total mark of 70*, and obtained *at least 70 percent* in the Repertoire section of the examination.

Candidates who choose to split the Teacher's ARCT examination are permitted to take a maximum of *one* supplemental examination in each part (practical and *Viva Voce*) of the Teacher's ARCT examination.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

General Instructions


- All scales, arpeggios, and broken and solid double stops are to be played from memory, ascending and descending, in the stated keys, with the required bowings. Candidates may use either the suggested fingering or another logical pattern.
- Intonation, tone quality, and fluency are important factors in the evaluation of a candidate's performance.
- Metronome markings are intended as guidelines for expected speeds at each grade.
- For complete technical requirements, please refer to the charts given for each grade in this Syllabus.
- Complete technical requirements and a selection of studies are also published in The Royal Conservatory of Music Violin Series, 2nd edition: Technical Requirements (Mississauga: Frederick Harris, 1999).

Small Hands Exemption

Grade 10 candidates with small hands may request exemption from playing 10ths and fingered octaves. Request must be submitted in writing with the examination application.

Three-octave Scales

- Candidates for Grades 6, 7, and 8 may use any one of the three patterns in the example below.
- Candidates for Grades 9 and 10 are required to use the Galamian-style pattern (a).
