Global Warming
Global warming is the increase in the average temperature of the Earth's atmosphere and oceans over time. This is caused by the greenhouse effect, where greenhouse gases trap heat in the atmosphere. The primary cause of global warming is the increase in greenhouse gas concentrations, particularly carbon dioxide, due to human activities such as burning fossil fuels and deforestation.



Acid Rain
Acid rain is precipitation that is acidic due to atmospheric pollution. It is caused by the release of sulfur dioxide and nitrogen oxides into the atmosphere, which react with water to form sulfuric and nitric acids. Acid rain can damage forests, buildings, and aquatic life.
