petite chicken parmesan

a miniature version of an italian classic; crispy breaded boncless chicken stuffed with mazzarella and served with italian marinara sauce for dipping

petite citrus "martini" shrimp

shrimp marinated and poached in citrus and cilantro vinaigrette served in a mini martini glass over a bed of black bean, corn and cucumber salsa finished with fresh guacamole and crispy tortilla straws

egaplant parmesana

this miniature version of the vegetarian favorite features Italian eggplant and mozzarella cheese breaded and fried until crispy, accompanied by basil marinara sauce

classic bruschetta

traditional italian combination of marinated roma tomatoes, fresh italian basil, garlic and imported parmesan-reggiano on garlic crostini finished with a drizzle of extra virgin olive oil

mini angus sliders

miniature all-beef burger seasoned to perfection, served on a freshly baked petite bun with wisconsin sharp cheddar, dill pickle slices and a splash of our signature steak sauce

mini strawberry shortcake

a grilled sweet strawberry with an madagascar vanilla cream served with sugar crusted biscuits in a mini martin glass.

- Students who need to clear something (obligations, SSL, credits) will not receive their caps and gowns until all requirements met




Graduation Rehearsal- June 12
