JFK was named to 2020 U.S. News and World Report <u>Best High Schools list</u>. CONGRATS!

As communicated to district superintendents on 9/18, the fall block testing for MCAP Algebra 1 and ELA 10 assessments in high school are cancelled (originally scheduled for Dec 7- Jan 29). The spring assessment window is still scheduled to occur. The MCAP Government and HS MISA assessments will still occur: Jan 4 – Jan 29, 2021.

Construction/Equipment:

- Building expansion project (actual construction begins spring/summer 2021)
- Including turf field for stadium
- Parking lot flow will change; tennis courts will be raised and parking will be underneath (similar to BCC)

- Question: what will happen to parking and tennis courts during construction? Answer: probably only sections of parking lot will be blocked off; hoping construction will take place in tennis off-season.
