PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Hot Topic: County Council Legislation about School Resource Officers (SROs)

- At least 2 council members (including Will Jawando) want to remove the SROs from the schools.
- Dr. Rubens does not agree w/ Mr. Jawando. Dr. Rubens feels the data around arrests is misleading (arrests of school-age youth that happen in the community are combined with those that occur on school grounds).
- JFK's SRO Kristy Palmer has been w/ JFK for 6 years, there have been less than 5 arrests in that time. She comes to all the football games. Some students develop personal relationships w/ SROs; this allows students to see officers in "another light" & is usually a positive experience.
- Dr. Rubens believes there should be a few tweaks to the SRO MOU.
- Dr. Smith & Board of Ed will make the ultimate decision. Dr. Rubens said all 22 schools that have SROs agree the SROs should stay.
