**RESOURCE:** The [Maryland Community College Promise Scholarship](#) is available each academic year to students who enroll at a Maryland community college. Eligible students may receive up to \$5,000 to cover any remaining tuition and mandatory fee expenses after Federal or State financial aid has been applied. All interested applicants must submit either the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid](#) (FAFSA) OR [Maryland State Financial Aid Application](#) (MSFAA) by March 1 each year.

**Tips & Tools for Applying & Accepting Financial Aid in the State of Maryland • [FAQ's](#) • The Maryland College Aid Processing System (MD CAPS)** accounts for accepting financial aid. Set up the MD CAPS account using this [link](#). Complete the FAFSA by March 1 (check individual college deadlines for priority date due). Check your MD CAPS account on a regular basis after filing the FAFSA. Complete all items on the checklist. Links and forms for documents required will be available to download in your MD CAPS account.

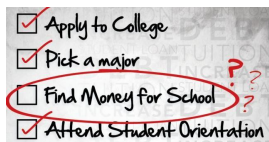
**From the Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC) on the Maryland Community College Promise Scholarship.** The Maryland Community College Promise Scholarship is a **last dollar award**, available to students who plan to enroll in credit-bearing coursework leading to a vocational certificate, certificate, or an associate degree. For scholarship consideration students must complete the FAFSA or MSSFA by March 1. [mhec.maryland.gov](#).

**Update from the Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC) on the Howard P. Rawlings Educational Assistance Grant & Guaranteed Access Grant Program.** The Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) will identify students that potentially meet grant eligibility based on information obtained on the student's FAFSA. Priority consideration requires that the FAFSA be filed by March 1. For more information, visit [mhec.maryland.gov](#).
