Boys' Basketball Information Flyer

The primary purpose of the *Basketball* program is to provide the opportunity for advanced skill development for all students in Grades 7 and 8 with interests and/or talents in *Basketball*.

Preseason Requirements

Registration

Registration for middle school basketball will open at **12 p.m.** on **Monday, October 31, 2022** and should be conducted through the [ParentVUE Portal](#). Students should complete their [pre-participation physical \(MCPS Form SR-8\)](#) so that the medical eligibility form (last two pages of SR-8) is ready for online submission via the ParentVue Portal or for email submission to the local school [athletic coordinator](#), prior to tryouts/practices. This form is valid for two years from the date of the exam and covers participation for all sports within that time period. This form must be completed and/or on file before a student-athlete can participate. All physicals must include the COVID-19 supplemental information, attached to the [pre-participation physical \(MCPS Form SR-8\)](#). Parents/guardians are also able to scan and upload their student's physical, as part of the registration process.

Eligibility

Students having a 2.0 average with no more than one "E" (failure) in the previous marking period automatically will be eligible to participate or practice in any extracurricular activity governed by this regulation during the next marking period.

Team Selection

Coaches will share with students the selection criteria being utilized during tryouts to determine team selection at the **December 16, 2022** tryout meeting in *B101*. Students wishing to discuss their team selection should schedule a meeting with *Mr. Nicolas Sevilla*.

Season Requirements

Practices

Students are expected to attend all practices. Practices will be held on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays on school days. Practice will start at 3:20 pm and end at 4:20 pm. An activity bus is provided to transport student's home after practice. Students unable to attend practice each day should consult with *Mr. Sevilla* prior to tryouts.

Games

Students are expected to attend all games. Games will begin at 3:20 pm. Transportation is provided to and from *Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Middle School* for away games. From *MLK*, athletes must provide their own transportation home.

Uniforms

Students will be issued a jersey for use in games. Students must return this uniform upon conclusion of the season, in order to avoid a financial obligation.
