Dear Eighth Grade Students and Parents/Guardians,

All eighth-grade students are invited to attend an end of the school year celebration at Smokey Glen Farm in Gaithersburg on Wednesday, June 14, 2023. The Smokey Glen trip is designed to reward students for their academic efforts and for their demonstration of our school's core values this year. Students will leave Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Middle School by MCPS bus at 9:40 a.m. and will return to school around 2:15 p.m.

Permission forms and payment of \$59.00 are due to Mr. Jackson no later than Monday, June 5, 2023. The trip payment includes bus transportation, admission to the farm, a lunch buffet, and recreational activities. While at the farm (no animals), students will also enjoy great food, team sports, horseshoe, miniature golf, and a moon bounce. The eighth-grade staff would like all students to participate in this end of year celebration. In order to be eligible to attend the trip, students must continue to uphold our school's core values of **Respect**, **Responsibility** and **Integrity** Students may be excluded from the trip if they:

- Are not academically eligible (below 2.0) at the end of the day on Friday, June 9.
- Have an outstanding financial or material (e.g. uniform, Chromebook) obligation.
- Receive a referral or are suspended between May 10 and June 13.
- Arrive late to a class without a valid pass three or more times between May 10 and June 13.
- Fail to attend a detention assigned by a staff member.
- Engage in behaviors that are considered disruptive, inappropriate, and/or unsafe.
- Do not follow expectations on earlier field trips.

Students who are removed from the trip for any reason will only be eligible for a refund of that portion of the field trip fee which has not already been encumbered by MLK MS as of the date of exclusion. However, no refunds will be made after Tuesday, June 6. Students not attending the trip will have a regular day of classes on June 14.
