Objective: Students will be able to use their research skills to gather information on a specific drug and create an informational PowerPoint Presentation

When you are done researching, begin designing/creating your PowerPoint presentation. You will be presenting your research to the class using your PowerPoint presentation. Be sure to site the resources using Noodle Tools.

### **Mandatory Information to be included in your PowerPoint Presentation:**

\*\*A slide, with a heading, for each should be included\*\*

1. The name of the drug and the drug category
2. Origin/History
3. Slang/Street Terms for the drug (at least 5)
4. How is it administrated (smoked, injected, etc.)
5. What are the PHYSICAL effects of the drug? BOTH long term and short term effects (How does it affect the body?)
6. What are the PSYCHOLOGICAL (mind) effects of the drug?
7. What are the withdrawal symptoms associated with the drug, if any? Treatment available?
8. What is the rate of teens using the drug currently in the country?

### **Design of PowerPoint Presentation:**

1. Creative Title – Include names and period number
2. At least 10 slides, including the title and word cited page
3. At least 4-5 Pictures – [www.picsearch.com](http://www.picsearch.com)
4. Easy to follow – not too wordy!
5. Free of grammar and spelling errors

### **Cited Sources:**

- A minimum of 3 sources must be used for this project. One of the sources should be a resource book
- Sources should be cited, using Noodle Tools, on the last slide of the PowerPoint presentation
