What is Mindfulness?


Mindfulness is about self awareness.




It means to pay full attention to what is happening in the present moment and to notice when distracting thoughts pull us away from where we are.


Staying in the present moment helps you reduce anxiety, stop worrying, and feel more connected to yourself and everything around you.
