What is ROCK Time?

ROCK Time is a daily 54 minute block that is designed for students to engage in activities of their choice that promote their academic, social, and emotional wellbeing. It is called ROCK Time because students and staff will be working together to promote our ROCK values of Responsibility, Optimism, Courage, and Kindness.

 Mondays and Fridays: All students will have the entire block to eat lunch in a location of their choice (cafeteria, outdoors, or media center) and participate in social activities. This is a time when interest clubs may meet, students can walk, run, or play outdoors, read books or play games in the media center, etc.
 Students also have the option to visit a teacher for extra academic support.





- Tuesdays and Thursdays: Students will report to their advisory class (like a homeroom) for 24 minutes to work on homework, projects, refine their skills on the IXL platform, or visit teachers for academic support. The remaining 30 minutes are designated for lunch in a location of their choice (cafeteria, outdoors, or media center). On these days, 6th and 7th grade students will eat lunch, then report to advisory. Eighth grade students will report to advisory first, then eat lunch.
- Wednesdays: Students will report to their advisory class for an SEL (social-emotional learning) lesson for 24 minutes, and the remaining 30 minutes are designated for lunch in a location of their choice. The same rotation for lunch and advisory are applied here. SEL lessons are designed by our counseling team and are tailored to the developmental needs and interests of each grade level.
